## What is the cost?

Tuition is as follows:

\$600 *before* May 1st

\$650 *after* May 1<sup>st</sup>

Tuition is due in full by July 1<sup>st</sup> and is payable by cash or check only. A nonrefundable deposit of \$100 is required in order to save your slot. If the remaining balance is not received by July 1<sup>st</sup>, your space may be given to the next student on the waiting list.

## Refund Policy:

The deposit is non refundable. Before July 1<sup>st</sup>, you may request a refund for any other tuition funds that have been paid.

## Should students bring their own instruments?

Guitar and bass yes, but we provide amps, chords, drum sets, microphones and keyboards
